

Voting Keypad Instructions

Will turn green after each vote.



Please look at your keypad and note response buttons 1-9. (You may ignore the letters for Council voting.)

- To vote YES, press "1." Watch for the number to display in the window and the green confirmation light.
- To vote NO, press "2." Watch for the number to display in the window and the green confirmation light.
- To change your vote, re-enter your selection. The system will record your last entry.
- To enter multiple choices for a single question or ballot, press the desired buttons in succession. <u>Please watch for</u> <u>each number to display in the window and the green</u> <u>confirmation light for each selection.</u>
- For the first ballot of the Board elections, press the corresponding number assigned to each candidate you wish to vote for, one after the other <u>please watch for each number to display in the window and the green confirmation light for each selection</u> for a total of 4 choices. The system will record the last 4 buttons pressed. Voting for fewer than 4 choices will automatically generate an invalid ballot.
- To change your vote, re-enter the corresponding numbers for your 4 candidate selections. <u>Please watch for each</u> <u>number to display in the window and the green</u> <u>confirmation light for each selection.</u> The system will record the last 4 buttons pressed.
- You will have 30 seconds to vote on each ballot.
- Responses are transmitted automatically as indicated by the window display and green confirmation light.
